

### 1. Why was the survey developed?

The Queensland Critical Minerals Industry (QCMI) ESG Capability Survey has been developed under the AusIMM and Queensland Government ESG Partnership. It is designed to capture perceptions on Environmental Social and Governance (ESG) capability and awareness, along with identifying needs and initiatives to support capability uplift.

# 2. Who is the survey for?

All QCMI stakeholders are invited to have their say, including ESG professionals, companies, value chain members, as well as other interested or affected parties including community members.

### 3. What if I don't have a lot of knowledge of QCMI or ESG?

Your perspectives are still important as they will inform what is needed to support capability. Further, the results will provide a baseline for the survey to be replicated in the future to understand progress.

# 4. When will the survey be open?

The survey is open from 17 March - 17 April 2025.

# 5. How can the survey be completed?

The survey can be completed on desktop or laptop computers, tablets or mobile devices. However, for best functionality, we suggest completing it on a desktop or laptop.
